

IRISH SETTER BREED NOTES
W/C MONDAY 3RD MAY 2021

Following last week's notes Pat Butler-Holley got in touch to say "Hun Gr Ch Erinade Extinguished was owned by Emese Boros who takes photos of Marta Magi's dogs. Marta had a dog by Extinguished and they have remained friends all this time. Marta lost her dog and then came to me for a bitch who was the foundation bitch of the Sangarah kennel in Hungary."

I believe the bitch in question was Int Sh Ch Shandwick Obsession aka Sarah (Sh Ch Scotselaw Jackson At Lynwood Connor J.W. ex Shandwick Reason To Believe)

Laura Kolbach also mentioned E. Extinguished "Erinade Extinguished "Robin", imported to Hungary by Emese Boros with the Berboss affix, played a big role in giving the breed a quality touch in that part of the world. He's done really well in the show ring too for his owner all across Europe. (my first Setter was his daughter and I was so proud!)"

Pat also remembers Viveca well as they served on the committee of the ISBC together when Pat was show secretary and Veca was show manager. They worked together to put on the Silver Jubilee show in April 1997 when their husbands had the job of laying the green carpet that they had acquired after Crufts.

I don't know about Veca's husband Doug but I do know that Pat's husband Mike will never forget trying to lay it straight and all the vacuuming he had to do!

Sh Ch Erinade Scottish Union was the sire of 5 show champions.

In 1981 Mrs Follows mated Fondador Manyana to him the result of which was Sh Ch Fondador Charlane, who was always handled by Lynn Muir, and from 1983 to 1989 won 21 CCs and 15 RCCs. On Brenda Berry's first CC appointment in 1984, when she did the bitches only at LKA, she gave Charlane her first ticket and Reserve to Caspians Affodile, her only such award. A Wheeler gave her CC #2 at Manchester with Amberwave Whispering Wind taking her second of two RCCs. Viv King titled her at Bath and gave the RCC to Redfield Sunbird.

Myra McLeish had a bitch called Drumwood Juliana who was a Sh Ch C. Lovebird great-granddaughter and great-great granddaughter and put to Scottish Union, who was also a Lovebird great-grandson and great-great grandson, in 1983 she bred Sh Ch Myresden Gabrielle. She won 4 CCs and 4 RCCs. David Tobin gave her her first at GBAS in 1984 and gave the RCC to Sh Ch Burfield Blue Bijou. David judged the dogs as well that day and awarded the CC to Scottish Union, his second, and a 6th RCC to Laggan Bryan's Boy.

In 1985 Cath McMurrish was the judge at Border Union and she gave Gabrielle her second CC. Sh Ch Dunnygask Spirit of Spring took the Reserve. Later in the year at Leeds Des McGarry made her up with Sh Ch Ryesford Lady Galadriel winning the Reserve.

Jenny Reed did a complete outcross mating to S. Union in 1984 which resulted in Sh Ch Tatterslee Toute Seule who was out of Topham Trophy At Tatterslee (Goldings Nimrod ex Tatterslee Topaze). The road to her title was a long one. Sybil Lennox judged at ISCW in 1988 and gave her her first with Shannonlee Irish Velvet taking her only ever RCC. It was two years before she won her second CC which was at MISS when Viv King was the judge. Sh Ch Amberwave Moonlight Shadow was Reserve to her. She won four of her 6 RCCs between 1990 and 1991 and then, finally, at Three Counties in 1993 Lis Rose-Hay made her up from Veteran. There were so many happy tears shed that day.

Mary Bowman, who had bred Veca's foundation bitch, Bonahaird Sierra, used S. Union on her Cornevon African Violet and in 1984 produced her successful 'Snow' litter; four of them qualified for Crufts in 1986.

Mr & Mrs Bateman's Bonahaird Snowtime won a RCC from Rae Furness at Border Union in 1990 when Sh Ch Wickenberry Pretty Polly won her 4th CC.

Mary's own B. Snowboots won 4 CCs and 8 RCCs. Her first was from Eleanor Scott-Gentles at NGA in 1986 and Shandwick Golden Spray won her 6th RCC. #2 came from Val Whitehead at LKA at the end of the year when Sh Ch Fondador Charlane won her 10th RCC.

It was two years later at Border Union in 1988 when Val Foss titled her; Caskey's Jezemy won her first of six RCCs.

In 1984 Chris Sheldon had a litter by him in which was her Sh Ch Delsanto Cassandra out of Fondador Martinique. In the years 1986 to 1992 she won 5 CCs and 7 RCCs. Her first ticket was at Setter & Pointer in 1987 from Marjorie Jarosz who gave the RCC to Sh Ch Clonageera Samantha of Whimbrel. Roy Rout judged bitches for the first time at Merseyside Gundog in 1988 and gave her her second; Goldings Hella took the RCC. Val Lyons' first ticket appointment was at SKC in 1989 and she made her up; Forever Amber by Starchelle won her only RCC.

E. Scottish Union's sire was Glentarkie Craven-A and when he was nearly 11 he was put to Eve Gardner's Carnbargus Racing Silk and produced Ch Carnbargus Cashmere who won 3 CCs. The first was in 1986 from Maurice Webb at Driffield; Sh Ch Fondador Charlane was Reserve.

Jack Houghton gave her her second at Three Counties in 1987 and Charlane took the RCC again. Olga Hampton made her up at Richmond later that year when Dunnygask Linnnet won her only ever RCC.

E. Scottish Union had a sister called E. Ransy Tansy who was owned by Lynne Leach. In 1983 she whelped a litter to Fondador Milwalkie and Lynne kept a dog who was to become Sh Ch Erilynne Sirocco. He won 4 CCs and 3 RCCs in total his first CC being from Ivor Gittins at ISCW in 1986.

Corriecas Gideon was Reserve to him that day.

The following year Moira Clark was the judge at SCCA and she awarded him his second with Reddins Fintan of Riqitta taking the RCC. Bob Heron titled him at East of England with Wendover Choirmaster being awarded his 4th RCC; he never won a CC for his owner Linda Richardson.

Sylvia Stocker owned Erinade Lewis (Sh Ch Bardonhill Supergrass J.W. ex Sh Ch Erinade Neula Of Norlan) who won his Junior Warrant and became a popular sire.
