Border Union is a favourite show for many; the setting by the River Tweed, is just lovely and the whole show has such a good feeling to it. Our judge was to have been Jeanette Walters (Deneil) who last judged the breed at NEEISC in 2017 when she did the dogs only. She gave the CC to Gwendariff D'Ya Know My Name by Bardonhill JW and the Reserve to Amblin's Sweet William.

The ISAE held an online Dog Show which attracted 220 entries and raised over £250 for their Health Fund. The judge was Gillian Townsend (Follidown) and for Best Dog and BIS she chose the winner of Open Czapal & Chalupa & Ostman 's Copper's Popsicle, Best Puppy Dog and also BPIS was Ixia Fennec Fox,. Best Bitch was the winner of Post Grad, Lucas' Pawsword Play With Fire Joins Amberlight and Best Puppy Bitch was Carnbargus Happy Returns. In Veterans Sh Ch Forfarian I'm Sexy An I Know It JW was the winner in dogs and Lochlorien Scully Foxes Andley ShCM won VB and BVIB. There were over 50 entries in The Rainbow Bridge class with the winner being Danaway Tonya.

There was a class for Baby Puppies with Tiroen To The Moon And Back taking top spot.

In 1993 Sh Ch Danaway Debonair was the third of the four Irish Setters to go Best In Show there; the judge was Leonard Pagliero OBE who had been Chairman of the Kennel Club from 1976 – 1981.

'DD' was owned and handled by Jackie Lorrimer and bred by Brian and Mary Gurney in February 1987.

His sire was 'Mack' aka Sh Ch Kerryfair NIghtfever and his dam was Sh Ch Disco Dancer Of Danaway.

Mack was a prolific sire with over 700 puppies registered by him including 27 Show Champions plus many other big winners.

Sh Ch D. Disco Dancer was out of Westerhuy's Dutch Spirit and by the Gurney's first Irish Setter Sh Ch Wendover Colas. A repeat mating produced Sh Ch Dunnygask Spirit Of Spring. D. Dancer was bred by Ailsa Harvey.

DD won his first CC with BOB at WELKS in 1989 from Penny Jeffries. He won the Reserve CC from Helen Flynn at Border Union that year and then his second CC at Blackpool from Ivor Gittins. Aidine Howes awarded him his crowning CC at Bournemouth also with BOB. He went on to win CCs in 1990, 91, 92, 93 and his 40th and final CC from Diane Irwin (Rishtte) at Darlington in 1994.

Of course, DD had also Best in Show at Crufts in 1993. He won the CC from his breeder Mary Gurney (it was allowed in those days) from an Open Class of 14 which included 6 Show Champions. The Reserve went to 2nd behind him, Dunnygask Red Grouse owned by Debbie Fryer and bred by Ailsa Harvey. Red Grouse's dam was Sh Ch Dunnygask Spirit Of Spring and therefore a grandson of W. Colas.

The bitch judge on that day was Jill Holley (Wynjill) who gave the CC to Alastair Watt's Shenanagin Sugar and Spice from Limit and the Reserve to Gill Mugford's Sh Ch Gimaroch Summer Dream.

The Crufts Group judge in 1993 was Ian Hampton and Best In Show judge was Tom Horner.

Reserve in the Group was the Welsh Springer Spaniel Sh Ch Russethill Royal Salute Over Nyliram owned by Tom Graham and Reserve Best In Show was Zena Thone-Andrews' Irish Wolfhound Ch Drakesleat Odyt. DD sired sired 22 litters with 153 pups registered.

Jill Holley used him on Wynjill Hope'N Glory to produce SA Ch Wynjill Dark'n Daring Of Danoak and he also produced Am Ch Sametsuz Ard-Righ to Magi Henderson's Sh Ch Honeypie Of Cornevon.

The mating to Geoff and Alycia Coup's Timadon Brulette resulted in two Show Champions; Sh Ch Timadon Airs And Graces and Sh Ch Timadon Debs Delight.

But of course, his most famous Show Champion son was Sh Ch Caspians Intrepid J.W. bred by Mike and Sue Oakley from Sh Ch Caspians Night Music.

There is much to write about the fourth of the Irish to win BIS at Border Union so I'll save it till next week.

The weather at Border Union varies between hot & sunny and cold & wet. I remember one year we went there with the caravan and it had rained so heavily in the run up to the show that it soon became like camping on the Somme. By the Friday night before the start of the show the driveways between the rows of caravans were nigh on impassable and like skid patches.

Me and MLM went out to fetch fish and chips for the four of us and as we drove back she announced that she's not going to drive up the row by the side of our caravan in case we get stuck.

Instead we are going a longer way round and will drive in by the side of the trees.

I asked if she was sure about that and she was. As we drove in some friends of ours were outside their caravan and were waving furiously at us.
