BENCHING AT GENERAL AND GROUP CHAMPIONSHIP DOG SHOWS

The Kennel Club would like to announce that following its recent Board meeting it has been agreed that the requirement for benching for General and Group Championship dog shows will be relaxed for a two-year trial period commencing the 1 January 2023.

This decision has been taken having listened to feedback from exhibitors and due to concerns expressed by show societies about the strain on shows' finances at this present time.

Applications for exemption from benching will now be considered by The Kennel Club for next year's shows. Those show societies which wish to apply for exemption from benching will be required to submit revised show plans and risk assessments. The Kennel Club will be contacting show secretaries direct with further details.

The Show Executive Committee will be regularly monitoring the impact on shows and Field Officers will be assigned to report on those shows for which exemption from benching has been approved. The Kennel Club can confirm that it will continue to provide benching at Crufts.

Her first appointment in Irish was at SCCA in 2003 when she awarded a crowning third CC to Sh Ch Amberwave Dazzle and second RCC to Bonhomie Theme For A Dream. This appointment was for bitches only.

In 2006 she judged both sexes at Midland Counties and found her CC winners in Sh Ch Gwendariff Dom Perignon and Kirkavagh Jumilla. RCCs were Sh Ch Thendara Don Corleone and Rua Primavara. 4 years later in 2010 she judged again at SCCA but this time she judged the dogs. The CC went to Sh Ch Ember Gene Simmons Sings Quensha and the Reserve to Copper's Undercover at Lynwood. The following year Maureen judged the bitches at ISCW and gave a second CC to Lynwood Started With a Kiss and a fourth RCC to Sh Ch Gwendariff Rock Diva.

Maureen was clearly a favourite at SCCA as her last appointment was there in 2013. Her dog CC winner was Sh Ch Meadway Morrisey and she gave a first CC to Neathamill Nerissa. She awarded a first and only RCC to Ixia Joseph At Merrybourne and a first RCC to Henaleas Carry On Flirting. Sincere condolences to her family and many, many friends.

In bitches David awarded a first CC to Maureen Elkins' Twoacres Promise Of Spring With Avacet who had won limit. She is 6 years old and by Sh Ch Avacet Snowdrift ex Twoacres Luck Be A Lady and also has 5 RCCs to her name.

The RCC went to Jane and Roger Mugford's Sh Ch Lynwood Abracadabra JW (Int Ch/Sh Ch Copper's Magiska Under ex Ch Lynwood Happy As A Lark J.W.).
