Entries for Setter & Pointer close on 29th October by post and at midnight on 6th November. Sandra Sturrock is judging both sexes.

Her last appointment was in 2019 when she judged bitches at NGA. On the day she titled Sh Ch Riverbrue Ophelia At Glennara and awarded the RCC to Lynwood Abracadabra. Sandra last judged dogs at Driffield in 2016 when her CC winner was Caispern Polonius and her RCC winner was Sh Ch Copper's War Of Roses.

There is an open show being held in conjunction with the championship show at which Chloe Green is judging the Irish.

Entries for the Sybil Lennox Memorial open show in aid of Irish Setter rescue close by post on 30th October and online at midnight 6th November. Pat Pike (Redclyst/Glenury) is the judge.

Pat's husband David is judging the breed at LKA the entries for which close by post today and online at 12 noon on the 1st November.

His last appointment was in 2020 when he judged bitches at MISS. His ticket winners were Millcroft Whispering Moon and reserve Millcroft Scarlet Moon. The last time he judged dogs he gave the CC to Sh Ch Avacet Snowdrift and the reserve to Lanstara Spring Moon. This was at SEISC in 2016. At Gundog Society of Wales last weekend, we had a change of judge as Suzy Roffey had Covid. The bitch RCC went to the mid limit winner, Julie and Paul Humphreys' Riverbrue Flashbax at Henaleas. This is Ci Ci's 3rd such award and she also has 1 CC. She was bred by Blake Crocker in December 2019 out of Sh Ch Riverbrue Gloriana by Jetsetter Calvin Klein (Imp Rus).

BPIB was the Misses Harvey's Cafotaliena She's On Fire who is 11 months old and out of Cassarla Coreopsis by Cataluna Maybe Baby.
